## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

Beginning Band is a course intended for students who have never played a band instrument prior to the start of the year. Students will learn basic musical notation reading, instrument care, and playing of a selected instrument.

## **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

- 1. To teach and develop basic musical concepts including, but not limited to, notation, pitch, dynamics, rhythm, tempo, harmony, and texture.
- 2. To teach ensemble skills including the ability to play together, follow a conductor, and exhibit proper stage presence and etiquette.
- 3. Perform various repertoires highlighting the various styles played by symphonic bands.
- 4. Become fluent with terms that are specific to band music.
- 5. To teach basic music history facts including performers, composers, and styles.
- 6. To adhere to the National Standards for Music Education.

## **REQUIRED MATERIALS FOR CLASS**

- Pencil
- Instruments
- Appropriate supplies (mutes, reeds, neck strap, valve oil, etc.)
- Standards of Excellence (Book 1), *will be ordered through the school (\$10)*
- Tuner/Metronome is HIGHLY encouraged, but is not required

## ASSIGNMENTS AND ASSESSMENTS

#### 1. DAILY POINTS (10 POINTS EVERY DAY)

- a. All students will begin the day with a full <u>10 points</u>
- b. Students will lose points based on the follow factors:
  - *i.* **2 pts <u>Tardy/Late</u>** *not in their seat when class begins*
  - *ii.* 2 pts <u>Not prepared for Class</u> *did not prepare for rehearsal outside of class*
  - *iii.* **2 pts <u>Lack of proper Equipment</u>** *no pencil, music, or has improper maintenance*
  - *iv.* **2 pts <u>Poor Attitude</u>** *has an attitude that is unwilling to work in class*
  - v. 2 pts <u>"FREE POINTS"</u> points can be lost if punishments are necessary

## 2. WEEKLY PRACTICE CARDS (50 POINTS EACH)

- a. Students will need to practice 2 hours (120 minutes) every week
  - *i.* It is recommended that each student practices 20 minutes everyday
  - *ii.* This will develop positive habits and the student will see more growth in their playing at a faster rate.
- b. Practice cards will need to be picked up by the student on Monday (or the first day in session for the week) and will need to turn the practice card in on the following Monday (or first day back in session in the week).
- c. Students will get points based on the following time schedule:
  - *i.* Under 60 Minutes = 0 points
  - *ii.* **60-74 Minutes = 30 points**
  - *iii.* **75-89 Minutes = 35 points**
  - *iv.* **90-104 Minutes = 40 points**
  - *v.* **105-119 Minutes = 45 points**
  - *vi.* **120 + Minutes = 50 points**
  - *vii.* For every 30 minutes over the required 120 Minutes, the student will receive 5 extra credit points.

#### 3. PLAYING EXAMS (50 POINTS EACH)

- a. Playing Exams will occur at a minimum of **ONCE** a week
  - *i.* Tests will be announced no later than 3 days before the test date.
  - ii. Tests will consist of lines out of the Standard of Excellence Book 1
- b. Points will be determined by the following criteria:
  - *i.* **10 pts <u>Tone Quality</u>** the student is able to make characteristic sounds (i.e. rolls, stokes, etc.)
  - *ii.* **10 pts <u>Preparation</u>** *the student is prepared and exhibits excellent preparation*
  - *iii.* **10 pts <u>Note/Rhythm Accuracy</u>** the student plays the correct notes at the correct time
  - *iv.* **20 Points <u>Appropriate Musicianship</u>** The student exhibits proper musicianship and plays appropriate dynamics, phrasing, articulations, etc.

## 4. PERFORMANCES (300 POINTS EACH)

- a. Points will be determined by the following criteria:
  - *i.* **30 pts <u>Preparation</u>** *the student has music, proper maintenance, and tuned properly*
  - *ii.* **60 pts <u>Punctuality</u> –** *the student shows up to the performance on time with the appropriate material*
  - *iii.* **60 pts <u>Concert Etiquette</u> –** *the student exhibits proper concert etiquette that will be covered during class, before the concert*
  - *iv.* **60 pts <u>Appropriate Attire</u> –** *the student is dressed appropriately as determined by the dress code that has been set for by the instructor*
  - *v.* **90 pts <u>Performance</u>** the student plays to the best of their ability as they have been instructed by the instructors

# **GRADING SCALE**

The grading scale is determined by the El Dorado Springs R-2 School District and can be found in the District Handbook.

## **CONCERT DRESS POLICY**

It is important for our concerts for the ensembles to look the most professional that they can. Students are expected to follow the attire set by the Director, as you can find below. This attire is consistent with all Middle School Band Students, and slightly different with the High School program. Students will not be allowed to perform if they choose not to adhere to the Concert Dress Policy. Also, if you need any help with your concert attire, please speak with Mr. White and he will be more than happy to help.

## **MISSED PERFORMANCE POLICY**

#### **Excused Absence**

If a conflict should arise with the performance schedule, students & parents should notify Mr. White IMMEDIATELY!

- If the absences is due to illness or death:
  - The student MAY NEED to write paper over a famous composer, musician, or instrument of their choice
- If the conflict is another <u>school</u> activity, the student will not need to do a make-up assignment.

#### **Unexcused Absence**

If the student chooses not to attend the performance or does not give prior notice to their absence, they will forfeit **ALL** of their points and will not be allowed to complete a make-up assignment.

## **PAYMENTS FOR GOODS**

The Director will decide on various products that the students will use throughout the year. These products are deemed as the best quality for the best price. It is the responsibility of the student and parent to make sure that their balance in their account is current. The Director will send home an updated account balance at the end of every quarter. Checks for these good need to be made out to "EHS."

When making a payment to Bulldog Band, the student will need to place all money (cash or check) into an envelope with the following information on the front. This system will help better track money for the Band Boosters and Mr. White.

## **COMMUNICATIONS**

#### **E-MAIL CORRESPONDENTS**
