#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

The High School Music Explorations class is a student-interest based class that is designed to cover various topics of the musical world. Some of the topics that may be covered are Music History, Music Appreciation, World Instruments, World Music, Instrumental Exploration, Composition, Music Technology, and Musical Impact on our World.

### **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

- 1. Give students more information and appreciation of the musical world.
- 2. Allow students to experiment with music.
- 3. Give students an in-depth look into music history.
- 4. Experience music that may not common to students.
- 5. Provide students with knowledge of music technology, terms, and composers.

#### **CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS**

- 1. Come to class ready to learn...EVERYDAY!
- 2. Attend all classes on time and with necessary materials.
- 3. Participate in class activities.
- 4. Have a respectful and enthusiastic attitude toward the teacher and fellow students.
- 5. Gum and food should be disposed of in the trash can BEFORE entering the classroom.
- 6. Do not lean or write on the music stands.
- 7. Display the highest respect for classroom visitors, students who are sharing information, and the instructor when giving instructions/lecturing.

#### **STUDENT PARTICIPATION**

Students are expected to contribute to the classroom discussion. This class will be based around the student's ability to help lead discussions. Since the instructor will not require REGULAR note taking and tests, it is expected that <u>ALL</u> students help further our discussions. Student engagement is what will drive the excitement for this course.

For you to have fun in this class, you will have to contribute to the classroom discussion!

Students will be asked to take a few notes and will have some playing tests (on piano) and a performance with the "Bucket Band" at the Christmas School Assembly.

## **ASSIGNMENTS AND ASSESSMENTS**

#### 1. DAILY POINTS (10 POINTS EVERY DAY)

- a. All students will begin the day with a full 10 points
- b. Students will lose points based on the follow factors:
  - i. **2 pts Tardy/Late** not in their seat when class begins
  - *ii.* **2 pts** *Not prepared for Class did not complete homework (if assigned)*
  - iii. 2 pts <u>Lack of proper Equipment</u> no pencil, paper, or work
  - iv. 2 pts Poor Attitude has an attitude that is unwilling to work in class
  - v. 2 pts "FREE POINTS" points can be lost if punishments are necessary

### 2. PRESENTATIONS (150 POINTS EACH)

- a. Points will be determined by the following criteria:
  - i. **30 pts Preparation** The student has prepared a comprehensive presentation
  - *ii.* **30 pts Information** The material presented is accurate
  - *iii.* **30 pts <u>Composure</u>** The student knows the information and is able to convey it to other students
  - iv. **30 pts <u>Form of Presentation</u>** Students should be creative in the way they present their information
  - v. **30 pts <u>Evaluations</u>** Students will be required to evaluate other students' presentations. The students should look for information that is new or interesting to them.

## 3. PLAYING EXAMS (50 POINTS EACH)

- a. Playing Exams will occur at a minimum of ONCE a week
- b. Points will be determined by the following criteria:
  - i. **10 pts <u>Tone Quality</u>** the student is able to make characteristic sounds (i.e. rolls, stokes, etc.)
  - *ii.* **10 pts Preparation** the student is prepared and exhibits excellent preparation
  - *iii.* **10 pts Note/Rhythm Accuracy** the student plays the correct notes at the correct time
  - iv. 20 Points Appropriate Musicianship The student exhibits proper

## MISSED PRESENTATION OR PLAYING TEST POLICY

Students will be required to make up their presentation or playing test, if they miss their scheduled day. The student will make up the presentation on the day they return. Be prepared if you miss a day. Students will know what day they will present at least 2 days before the presentations are to begin. Students need to let Mr. White know if they will be gone on a specific day, if it interferes with their presentation.
